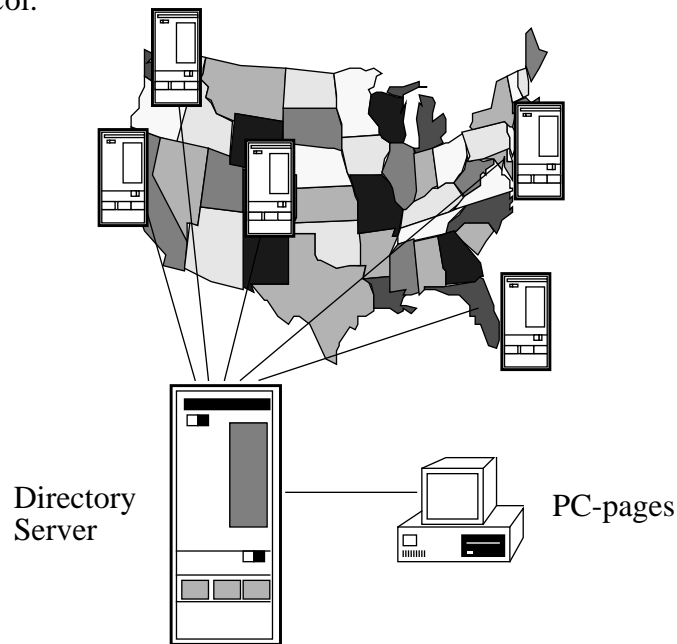

*h*ow does it work?

Data is stored in a distributed fashion, and communicated via national and international networks. Each participating site holds it's own information, with requests for information coming in and going out using the internationally standardized X.500 protocol.



*q*uestions answered

What about security?

Data stored using X.500 can be hidden from all except those who are supposed to see it. Safeguards can be emplaced which prevent unauthorized access to all or part of any data.

When will PC-pages be available?

PC-pages is currently undergoing preliminary testing. A full release of a Windows 3 version is planned for September 1992. A DOS only version is expected in late September 1992.

Why is it useful?

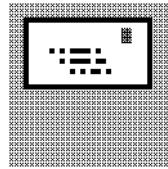
Data retrieved can be very rich. The following represent just some of the types of information that can be found.

- E-mail address.
- Postal address.
- Telephone, fax, telex address.
- Organizational relationships (e.g. secretary, role etc.).
- Graphical data (maps, personal photos).

Such information can then be utilised in a number of ways:

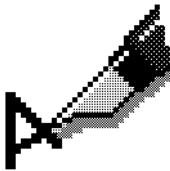
Whitemail

PC-pages is integrated with Whitemail. Thus mail addresses, phone and other data can be passed directly to Whitemail and it's associated address book application.

Data can be transferred to a word processor, in order to perform mail merges, etc.

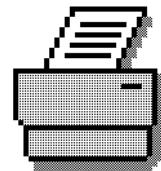

Printer


Directory entries can be printed as personal organizer pages, business cards or local directories.



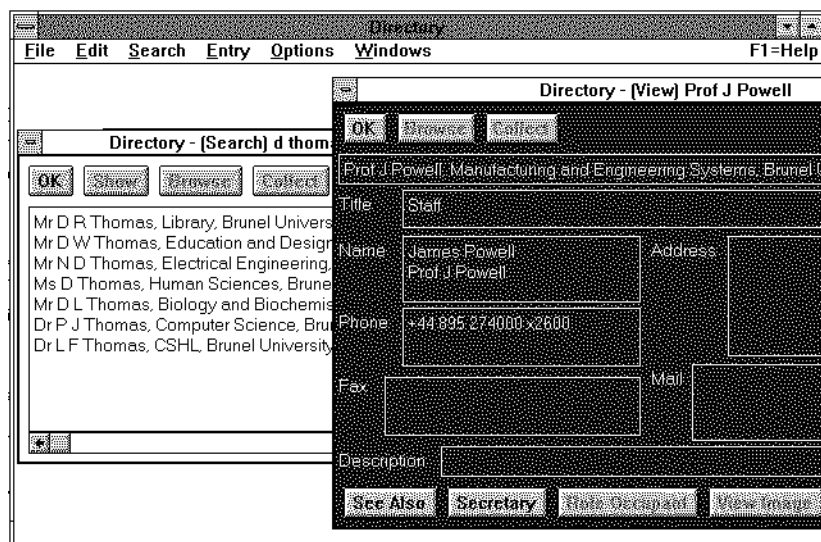
