
## Zenoss 4 Event Management Workshop

Zenoss provides comprehensive Open Source network and systems management.



The purpose of this workshop is to understand the underlying architecture of the Zenoss events subsystem, by completing a series of exercises designed to demonstrate many of the more subtle features of Zenoss. Logging and debugging techniques will also be discussed.

The aim of the workshop is to spend 90% of the time working hands-on. **Brief** introduction sessions will be conducted for each unit and the instructor will be available throughout to assist and answer questions.
